VOTING QUORUM:

When applicable, Sub-Committee and Executive Committee Members present at AREA plus GSRs in attendance at AREA so long as at least 50% of active meetings.

ABSTENTIONS:

- (1) Number of abstentions exceeds either the yeas or nays tabled and voted at next AREA
- (2) Number of yeas and nays and the number of abstentions is less than the yeas or nays then the AREA Chair shall act as the tiebreaking vote or the Vice-Chair in the Chair's absence

VOTING POSITIONS

GROUPS: Each has one vote through either the GSR or the Alt. GSR, if the GSR is not present. **SUB-COMMITTES**: Each has one vote through either Chair or Co-Chair, if chair is not present.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE: Each of the following have one vote:

Secretary or Alternate Secretary, if Secretary is not present

Treasurer or Co-Treasurer, if Treasurer is not present; and

Regional Committee Member (RCM) or Alternate RCM, if RCM is not present.

Executive Committee Members that do not have any vote:

Chair, Vice-Chair, Parliamentarian. However, Chair (and Vice-Chair when fulfilling duties of the Chair) shall have a vote at AREA but only in the case of a tie.

AREA LIAISON POSITIONS AND OTHER MEMBERS - do not have a vote at AREA
